Admission Requirements

Please enter all information correctly. Applicants are responsible for all omissions and errors.

All documents must be original.

Applicants who have graduated from Chinese universities must obtain and submit both the Online Verification Report of Higher Education Degree Certificate and the Online Verification Report of Higher Education Qualification Certificate from CHSI.

If an applicant who is expected to graduate is admitted, they must submit their Certificate of Graduation and Final Academic Transcript for the issuance of the Certificate of Admission.

Transfer students or dual degree holders must submit additional Academic Transcripts (notarized Korean or English Translation) from their previous universities.

If the transcript does not indicate the GPA scale and the maximum score, applicants may be required to submit a GPA conversion certificate based on a 100-point scale or percentage.

Academic documents must be issued within 2 years from the application date, while nationality and family-related documents must be issued within 1 year.

Documents not written in Korean or English must be submitted with a notarized translation in Korean or English.

Notarizations from Korean Notary Offices are not accepted.

Submitted documents will not be returned, and any case of false information, proxy writing, plagiarism, or other fraudulent activities will result in disqualification. If discovered after admission, acceptance and enrollment may be canceled.

Matters not specified in this admission guide shall be governed by the university's admission policies and procedures.

If the full amount of the admission and tuition fees is not paid within the designated registration period, admission will be canceled.


